

IIT- Bombay Explains Power of Homeopathy

Six months after the British Medical Association lasheel Homeopathy as witchcraft with no scientific basis, IIT scientists have said the sweet white pills work on the principle of nanotechnology.

In the latest research conducted by IIT , which is published in the latest issue of Homeopathy, a peer- reviewed journal from Medical publishing firm Elsevier, it was said that Homeopathic pills contain naturally occurring metals, such, as gold, copper and iron retain their patency even when diluted to a nanometer or one- billionth of a meter.

These results were found after students of IIT- B chemical engineering department bought Homeopathic pills from nearby shops, prepared highly diluted solution and checked these under powerful electron microscopes to find nano-particles of the original metal.

The research says that Homeopathy has been a mystery for modern medicine. Its practitioners maintained that Homeopathy pills got more potent of dilution, but they could never explain the mechanism scientifically enough for the modern scientist.
